Senko Receives "Excellent Business Entities Working on Modal Shift" Award from Japan Association for Logistics and Transport

Senko Co., Ltd. (President: Yasuhisa Fukuda, "Senko") and Runtec Corporation (President: Kazuhiro Yamanaka, "Runtec") have received the "Excellent Business Entities Working on Modal Shift" Award ("Excellent Business Award") from the Japan Association for Logistics and Transport (Chairman: Shuji Tamura, "JALoT").

The Excellent Business Award is an awards program aimed at announcing and rewarding business entities actively involved in efforts to bring about modal shifts.

Both Senko and Runtec were selected for a total of four Excellent Business Awards in the three categories of "Improvements," "Effective Utilization" and "New Developments."

Senko's efforts in the Improvements category were praised, with its utilization ratio of mainline rail and marine transportation exceeding 40%, which was an increase from the previous year ($63.4\% \rightarrow 65.7\%$).

In the Effective Utilization category, Senko was rewarded for its efforts in shifting from flexible intermediate bulk container truck transportation for resins to bulk container rail transportation between Tochigi Prefecture and Hyogo Prefecture, while Runtec was recognized for shifting transportation of frozen and chilled foods between the Kyushu and Tokai regions from trucks to rail containers.
