

Senko Boosts Logistics Capabilities in Shanghai Region, China

Full Operation of Qingpu Logistics Center



Shanghai Senko International Freight Forwarding Inc. (Representative: Kumeo Okada), the Chinese subsidiary of Senko Co., Ltd. (President: Yasuhisa Fukuda, "Senko"), has opened the "Qingpu Logistics Center" in Shanghai City and began full operations from May 2, 2018.

The Qingpu Logistics Center is located approximately 30 km west of Shanghai Hongqiao International Airport and around 3 km from the expressway interchange, making it ideal for accessing the Jiangsu and Zhejiang provinces.

The new logistics center is a two-story building with a high-floor truck berth (access for 22 trucks) designed for all weather conditions. Stringent security measures are also in place such as IC access control systems and surveillance cameras.

The first story of the center has an area of approximately 3,360 m² that can be used as a cold storage and frozen storage warehouse, which means the building also meets future requirements for three-temperature zone logistics.
