

"Gifu Hashima PD Center" Opens

- Expanding business in the Chubu region and creating employment opportunities -

SENKO Co., Ltd. (Head office: Kita-ku, Osaka City; President: Yasuhisa Fukuda; "Senko") opened the "Gifu Hashima PD Center (the "new center")" as the first large-scale logistics center located in Gifu Prefecture, on May 13.



The new center is ideally located some 600 m from the Gifu-Hashima interchange, and with well-developed highway systems such as the Tokai-Kanjo Expressway, will serve as a way to expand sales channels into the western region of Gifu Prefecture where businesses are anticipated to establish operations, as well as the Tokai and Hokuriku regions.

SENKO already owns logistics centers in Mizuho, Kakamigahara and Ogaki cities in Gifu Prefecture, however this is the first large-scale logistics center to be opened within the prefecture. The logistics center will hire around 90 staff members, which will create employment opportunities for the community.

The volume of freight handled by the logistics center in the Komaki district of neighboring Aichi Prefecture is increasing annually, and the new center will respond to this growing demand as well as help expand business by operating as a new distribution center serving the Chubu region.
