SENKO Shoji Develops Low-cost AGV "Carry-Taro"

- Ideal for Efficiency and Laborsaving in the Manufacturing Industry and Logistics Sites -



SENKO Group Holdings Co., Ltd. (Koto-ku, Tokyo, President: Yasuhisa Fukuda) group company SENKO Shoji Co., Ltd. (Koto-ku, Tokyo, President: Hiroshi Yoneji, "SENKO Shoji") has developed the automated guided vehicle (AGV : unmanned transport) "Carry-Taro" for operations at warehouses and factories, and began sales from March this year.

SENKO Shoji has forged a proven track record as a trading company handling materials used at logistics sites, and is focusing on developing original concepts that accurately address the needs of worksites as part of efforts to create new business fields.

The newly developed "Carry-Taro" was deployed at SENKO worksites for testing and also verified at the manufacturer's test environment, in order to narrow down functions to keep costs down. The AGV follows a magnetic guide tape system and operates by towing cargo instead of having cargo loaded on it. This makes it relatively easy to deploy at customer sites by simply adjusting the towing mechanism to suit the customers' own special trolleys.

The complicated way products are moved used to be handled by staff in the past, however leaving this task to "Carry-Taro" can help to reduce worker fatigue and more efficient personnel allocations. As the spread of novel coronavirus infections continues to increase, there will be greater demand for laborsaving throughout the manufacturing industry and logistics sites. "Carry-Taro" can take the place of staff to ensure continuous operations, and help boost productivity.
