

## Osaka Living Support Company, Venus Co. Ltd., Joins Senko Group

Senko Group Holdings Co., Ltd. ("Senko GHD") acquired all shares of Venus Co. Ltd. (Headquarters: Sakai City, Osaka; President: Nobuhiko Yasuda; "Venus") which runs a living support services business, on October 5, 2017, incorporating the company into the Senko Group.

Venus runs a nursing and preventative care business catering chiefly to elderly people, operating 43 facilities throughout Osaka Prefecture including the fitness-type half-day service "Venus Club," rehabilitation-type half-day service with bath "Venus Plus" and visiting care service "Visiting Care Station."

Senko GHD is expanding its living support services, and in October last year incorporated KEIHANNA helper station Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Nara City; President: Yoshinobu Kubo) as a group company that supports people in their daily lives by operating visiting care businesses and residential-type nursing homes. The incorporation of Venus into the group will serve to further expand nursing-related services with the aim of further increasing and expanding business.

By joining the Senko Group, Venus will be able to open branches in new areas as a way of expanding business.
