Nippon Marine Constructs Chemical Tanker "Kissho" Online Launching Ceremony Held Due to COVID 19 Measures

SENKO Group Holdings Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Koto-ku Tokyo; President: Yasuhisa Fukuda) domestic and overseas shipping group company Nippon Marine Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Minato-ku Tokyo; President: Ichiro Iwasaki, "Nippon Marine") launched the newly constructed chemical tanker "Kissho" on August 18.

"Kissho" was constructed to strengthen transportation services for existing customers, as well as to cover new marine transportation operations secured by SENKO Co., Ltd. (President: Yasuhisa Fukuda). The launching ceremony was held in June this year, and was conducted online using Zoom as part of efforts to prevent infections of COVID 19. The tanker will stop at ports around the Seto Inland Sea for transportation of concentrated sulfuric acid, fuming sulfuric acid and other cargo.
