

Tokyo Nohin Daiko Receives "MLIT Minister's Award for Companies Contributing to Environmental Conservation in the Transport Industry"

(Head office: Ichikawa City, Chiba; President: Hiroyuki Ito; "Tokyo Nohin Daiko") received the "2020 MLIT Minister's Award for Companies Contributing to Environmental Conservation in the Transport Industry" from the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism, and an awards ceremony was held on December 22, 2020 at the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (in Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo).

As the government implements initiatives aimed at achieving a carbon-free society, Tokyo Nohin Daiko worked with customers to roll out one of the first hangar-rack body type electric trucks in Japan in July last year. It is also making use of CNG vehicles powered by natural gas.
