# **Senko Group Craftsmanship Competition 2018**

Senko Group Holdings Co., Ltd. held the "Senko Group Craftsmanship Competition 2018" over two days on September 15 and 16, 2018 at Crefeel Koto (Higashiomi-shi, Shiga Prefecture), the company's traffic safety training facility.

Members from 46 group companies participated in the competition, with 113 qualifying contestants from each region (of which 8 were from overseas) competing with the techniques and skills they had acquired through their daily duties.

The competition was divided into three categories: "Driver Division," "Operator (Forklift) Division" and "Office (Telephone) Division."

There were a total of 50 contestants in the "Driver Division," testing their skills in "2 Ton," "4 Ton," "11 Ton" and "Trailer" classes.

Competition challenges included written theory, inspections covering daily maintenance, reversing abilities like reverse in slalom, reverse figure-S and confined parking, as well as general driving skills through the model city course.

There were 32 contestants in the "Operator Division" testing their techniques in the "Reach" and "Counterbalance" classes. Written theory and inspection skills were similar to the Driver Division, with additional forklift challenges including basic unloading and load switching techniques as well as advanced skills such as loading onto nested containers and pallet switching.

The "Office (Telephone) Division" had 31 contestants. During a 3-minute test based on the topic of "Customer satisfaction to customer delight: winning the hearts and minds of customers through detailed communication backed with human emotion," participants were tested on their customer response skills, including responding to requests from customers to send documents or scheduling appointments.
