Two Apparel Companies Join New Resource Recycling Platform Demonstration Project

ONWARD KASHIYAMA and SANYO SHOKAI Partner with SENKO Group to Participate in RECOTECH's Waste Plastic Resource Recycling Initiatives Using Integrated Forward/Reverse Logistics

ONWARD KASHIYAMA Co., Ltd. (Head office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo; President and CEO: Tsunenori Suzuki; "ONWARD KASHIYAMA") and SANYO SHOKAI LTD. (Head office: Shinjuku-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, President & Chief Operating Officer: Shinji Oe; "SANYO SHOKAI") have partnered with SENKO Group Holdings Co., Ltd. (Head office: Koto-ku, Tokyo; President and Representative Director: Yasuhisa Fukuda; "SENKO Group"), which provides logistics operations for both companies, to take part in a resource recycling platform demonstration project operated by RECOTECH inc. (Head office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President: Mamoru Nozaki; "RECOTECH") that utilizes integrated forward/reverse logistics to efficiently collect and recycle waste plastics.

[Background & Challenges]

With the growing severity of marine plastic pollution in recent years, the reduction and recycling of plastic waste has become an urgent issue. A 2016 report by the UK-based Ellen MacArthur Foundation warned that with currently available estimates, "Without significant action addressing the speed at which plastics are used today, there may be more plastic than fish in the ocean, by weight, by 2050."

In response to these circumstances, various initiatives are now being made on a global scale to develop a circular economy and achieve a sustainable society. Efforts are also being made throughout the Japanese apparel industry, with programs aimed at collecting clothes at stores for recycling or reuse. Yet the majority of plastics generated throughout the supply chain are only limited to thermal recovery, regardless of how clean those plastics are when collected. Efficient collection of the extremely broad range of waste plastics disposed of at logistics sites and stores is essential for materials recycling, and developing an industry-wide framework to achieve this is considered extremely important.


[Details of Demonstration Project]

ONWARD KASHIYAMA and SANYO SHOKAI have partnered with the SENKO Group, which covers the delivery and logistics operations for both companies, to take part in this resource recycling platform demonstration project that utilizes integrated forward/reverse logistics to efficiently collect and recycle waste plastics. The demonstration project involves sorting plastics disposed of at both

company's logistics warehouses, stores and other sites by weight and type, collecting the plastics using the SENKO Group's delivery vehicles, and recycling them at materials recycling plants.

The demonstration project uses the "Material Pool System (MPS)" resource recycling platform system and the "GOMiCO" waste material tracking web application provided by RECOTECH for tracking and managing the amount and types of waste plastics visually to ensure traceability of each process within the reverse supply chain. The project has received "recycling certification" from the Tokyo municipal government, making it possible to achieve integrated forward/reverse logistics using non-approved vehicles.

[Future Developments]

Initiatives involving many companies spanning numerous industries will be essential in the future to achieve waste recycling efforts that are difficult to implement for individual companies. To accelerate its efforts to develop a framework for efficiently recycling and reusing resources, RECOTECH is calling for participation by apparel companies that generate large quantities of clean plastic as well as other brands to join its resource recycling platform, and is asking each site to examine the amount of waste plastic generated from a broader perspective.
