

Senko Receives "Logistics Environment Award" from Japan Association for Logistics and Transport

Senko Co., Ltd. (President: Yasuhisa Fukuda, "Senko") and Kyushu Senko Logistics Co., Ltd. (President: Kazuhito Kuroki, "Kyushu Senko Logistics") has received the Logistics Environment Award from the Japan Association for Logistics and Transport (Chairman: Shuji Tamura, "JALoT").

The Logistics Environment Award was established in June 2000, and is given to organizations or companies that contributed to the development of the logistics industry by implementing superior environmental conservation or awareness activities, or developing innovative technologies, this time is the 19th commendation.

Three companies were given the award – Coca-Cola Bottlers Japan Inc. (President: Tamio Yoshimatsu), Senko and Kyushu Senko Logistics – were recognized for the joint initiative of "Modal shift for beverages from mainline truck transportation to rail transportation between Kyushu and Kansai," aiming to achieve significantly less environmental impact and more efficient logistics.

Furthermore, Senko was presented with the Special Logistics Environment Award for three other initiatives: "Modal shift for Futamura Chemical Co., Ltd. plastic film from mainline large truck transportation to rail transportation," "Modal shift for ADEKA Corporation and ADEKA Logistics Corporation processed oils from long-distance truck transportation to ferry transportation" and "Modal shift for Japan Novopan Industrial Co., Ltd. particle board to ship transportation including larger mainline transportation."

The Senko Group is planning to continue focusing on boosting modal shift initiatives to reduce environmental impact and enhance logistics efficiency.
