

"KIZUNA" Walk Relay Reaches Finish Line at Crefeel Koto

The "KIZUNA" Walk Relay held as part of Senko Co., Ltd. 100th anniversary activities reached the finish line at the company's logistics and traffic safety training center "Crefeel Koto" (Higashiomi City, Shiga Prefecture) on July 3, 2016.

The walk relay was held to show appreciation to the roads that Senko staff use during daily logistics operations, and staff from Senko Group companies, branches and offices took turns with sashes to walk along roads throughout the country.

Starting from Senko's "foundation monument" (Minamata City, Kumamoto Prefecture) on July 11 2016, staff from nine areas, Sapporo, Niigata, Chiba, Toyama, Mie, Nara, South Osaka, Minamata and Kagoshima, took turns to reach the goal of "Crefeel Koto."

Senko Group staff formed teams consisting of ten members, and a total of 198 teams each took turns to walk approximately 15 km.

Over the past year, 2,126 staff members walked a total of 3,005 km. There were also 335 staff members who provided assistance along the way.

There were thirty members who walked the final leg of the relay. The finish line at Crefeel Koto was also the venue for an orientation ceremony for new Senko Group staff, where some 280 executives and new employees awaited the arrival of staff walking the final leg of the relay.

The finish line event featured a video showing highlights from the walk relay over the past year, and President Fukuda, Vice President Fujimori and Vice President Tezuka handed the sashes to new employees who will lead the company over the next 100 years.
