

Competitor Hitoshi Okumura Scores First Win Shot Put at Japan Championships in Athletics!

The "107th Japan Championships in Athletics" was held at Yanmar Stadium Nagai (Higashisumiyoshi-ku, Osaka City) from June 1 to 4, where Hitoshi Okumura of the SENKO Track & Field Club scored his first victory in the Men's Shot Put event. He scored a distance of 18.42 m, exceeding his personal record of 18.26 m and tying with the seventh best record in Japan.



Hitoshi Okumura joined SENKO Co., Ltd. (Kita-ku, Osaka City) in April this year. He was a student at Kokushikan University until March, and came in first place at the Japan Inter-College Meet (All Japan University Track & Field Challenge Meeting), where he posted a new record.

The SENKO Track & Field Club was established in 2021, and mainly involves medium- to long-distance track and field events, and marathons. Members of the Club participated in the "Princess Ekiden" in October last year, accomplishing the goal of entering an Ekiden event set out when the club was established. The club has a total of 13 members, including new athletes in events like short-distance sprints, long jump and throwing sports.

Hitoshi Okumura and other members of the Track & Field Club will continue giving it their best to achieve even greater results into the future.
